Upton Sinclair

Between the early 1920s and the early 1930s Heartfield's brother Wieland Herzfelde published 37 books by the popular American socialist Upton Sinclair. The powerful cover designs by Heartfield were one of the factors that ensured that German sales of some of his socially critical novels exceeded those in the US, even though Sinclair was one of the most popular writers of his day in his home country.
